Eduardo S. Brondizio is Distinguished Professor of Anthropology and Director of the Center for the Analysis of Social-Ecological Landscapes (CASEL) at Indiana University Bloomington, USA.

He also holds faculty positions at the University of Campinas, and at the National Institute for Space Research, Brazil.

Having worked in the Amazon for the past three decades, he maintains a field-based research program focusing on the interactions between rural and urban populations and land use change, development programs and markets, urbanization and environmental change.

The author of more than 200 scientific publications, he has served on numerous international scientific boards in the Americas, Europe, and Asia, having contributed in leading roles to several global and regional assessments.

Brondizio serves as Co-Editor-in-Chief of *Current Opinion in Environmental Sustainability*. He is currently one of the three Co-chairs of the IPBES Global Assessment of Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services.
