He was a Coordinating Lead Author in the Fifth Assessment Report of the IPCC and previously served as Coordinating Lead Author and Lead Author in the Pollination and Asia-Pacific Assessments of IPBES. He is currently one of the three Co-chairs of the IPBES Global Assessment of Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services.
